Owens the Environmental Reserve (ER), a strip usually 6-30m wide depending on the site, between the cottage lot pins in subdivisions and the normal high water mark. (Usually there is no ER between a water body and a 30+ year old subdivision cottage lot, an acreage residence, or a farm residence.)

Approval from the County is required for works conducted on an ER.

Public Lands Division

In most cases owns the land below the normal high water mark of lakes and streams, i.e. the Crown-owned bed and shore.

Approval is required for any works or activities that may alter or harm the bed or shore of water bodies.
